To address this concern, a coalition was formed in Ahmedabad, Gujarat, India, to develop an evidence-based heat preparedness plan and early warning system. This article describes the group and the first steps in developing and implementing the plan. Evidence collection included a comprehensive literature review, analysis of local temperature and mortality data, studies of heat-sensitive populations, focus groups of health professionals and expert consultations. The results and recommendations were compiled into action manuals for central government agencies, health workers, field workers and slum communities and synthesized into a warm preparedness plan. In addition, a 7-day probabilistic weather forecast has been developed to be used to begin planning ahead of dangerous heat waves.
